When choosing a mount cutter, consider the type, size and quantity of work you plan to do. The most important factor is anticipating the largest board you plan to cut: you cannot cut mounts bigger than the cutter is designed for. After that, the choice is based on affordability and the volume of work expected. The more sophisticated the machine, the more consistent, accurate and speedier your mount cutting will be, and you can achieve more complex and creative cutting styles on the pro-machines. Take time to set up and fine tune your mount cutter, and you will work without any annoying niggles.



To help judge a system's cutting capacity, we have outlined below the range of metric paper sizes.

The 'Maximum Board Size' is the biggest board that will fit under the guide rail. It is the outside dimension of the sheet, not the aperture.

The 'Maximum Border Depth' is how far from the edge of the board you can cut with the bevel cutter. You can go further with all cutters but without the parallel guide

All these Logan board mounted cutters have a craft knife or a straight cutter supplied for cutting board to size. On the top-end machines one is integrated into the design

This is the cut direction; pull cutters are preferable for long cuts as the push cutter can be difficult to control when you are at full reach.

Production stops allow for accurate corners cuts and quicker repetition cutting if you are making several mounts the same.

The higher end mount cutters have an arm that the mount board sits against, ensuring that the cut is square, speeding up the sizing of the board.
